
*Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Seventy-fourth General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

That in the Rules of the House of Representatives, Rule No. 25, **amend** (f.5)(3) as follows:

### **25. Committees**

- (f.5) (3) If the chair receives a complaint against a member of the House of Representatives or a partisan staff person of the House of Representatives under the Workplace Harassment Policy, the chair shall convene a meeting of the House Workplace Harassment Committee to consider the complaint and shall proceed in accordance with the Workplace Harassment Policy. Pursuant to the Workplace Harassment Policy and section 24-6-402 (3)(a)(III), Colorado Revised Statutes, meetings of the House Workplace Harassment Committee may occur in executive session. Additionally, pursuant to section 24-72-204 (3)(a)(X.5), Colorado Revised Statutes, all documents related to any complaint are confidential and are not subject to public inspection, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN

SECTION 24-72-204 (9), COLORADO REVISED STATUTES, OR  
AS PERMITTED UNDER THE WORKPLACE HARASSMENT  
POLICY.
