Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB24-048 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend the Business, Labor, and Technology Committee Report, dated  
2 March 21, 2024, page 2, strike line 10 and substitute:

3           **""SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 23-18-308, **add**  
4 (1)(m) as follows:

5           **23-18-308. Fee-for-service contracts - grants to local district**  
6 **colleges - limited purpose - repeal.** (1) Subject to available  
7 appropriations, the department shall enter into fee-for-service contracts  
8 for the following purposes:

9           (m) THE RECOVERY-FRIENDLY WORKPLACE PROGRAM CREATED IN  
10 PART 3 OF ARTICLE 20 OF THIS TITLE 23.

11           **SECTION 3.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 22-1-144 as".

12 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.

13 Page 3 of the Report, line 24, strike "TWO HUNDRED".

14 Amend printed bill, page 17, before line 20 insert:

15           **"SECTION 7. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2024-25 state fiscal  
16 year, \$144,321 is appropriated to the department of education. This  
17 appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the  
18 department may use this appropriation as follows:

19           (a) \$19,010 for use by management and administration for grants  
20 administration, which amount is based on an assumption that the division  
21 will require an additional 0.2 FTE;

22           (b) \$56,300 for use by management and administration for  
23 information technology services; and

1 (c) \$69,011 for use by student pathways for the substance use  
2 disorders recovery grant pilot program, which amount is based on an  
3 assumption that the division will require an additional 0.2 FTE."

4 (2) For the 2024-25 state fiscal year, \$303,752 is appropriated to  
5 the department of higher education. This appropriation is from the general  
6 fund. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation  
7 for the college opportunity fund program to be used for limited purpose  
8 fee-for-service contracts with state institutions.

9 (3) For the 2024-25 state fiscal year, \$303,752 is appropriated to  
10 the department of higher education. This appropriation is from  
11 reappropriated funds received from the limited purpose fee-for-service  
12 contracts with state institutions under subsection (2) of this section, and  
13 is based on an assumption that the department will require an additional  
14 1.3 FTE. To implement this act, the department may use this  
15 appropriation for the regents of the university of Colorado for allocation  
16 to the school of public health.

17 (4) For the 2024-25 state fiscal year, \$37,980 is appropriated to the  
18 department of revenue for use by the liquor and tobacco enforcement  
19 division. This appropriation is from the liquor enforcement division and  
20 state licensing authority cash fund created in 44-6-101, C.R.S. To  
21 implement this act, the division may use this appropriation as follows:

22 (a) \$30,798 for personal services, which amount is based on an  
23 assumption that the division will require an additional 0.4 FTE; and

24 (b) \$7,182 for operating expenses."

25 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

26 Page 1, line 101, strike "**DISORDERS.**" and substitute "**DISORDERS, AND,**  
27 **IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.**".
