Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB24-064 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 4, strike lines 6 through 14.
- 2 Renumber succeeding subsection accordingly.
- 3 Page 4, line 27, strike "portion" and substitute "portion; and **add** (1)(f)".
- 4 Page 5, line 3, strike "describing" and substitute "~~describing~~ USING THE  
5 STANDARD FORM OF EVICTION COMPLAINT AND AFFIDAVIT FOR A  
6 RESIDENTIAL TENANCY THAT IS AVAILABLE ONLINE THROUGH THE  
7 JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT'S WEBSITE TO DESCRIBE".
- 8 Page 5, after line 7 insert:  
9 "(f) NOTWITHSTANDING THE REQUIREMENT TO FILE A COMPLAINT  
10 USING THE STANDARD FORM OF EVICTION PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1)(a)  
11 OF THIS SECTION, THE COURT SHALL ACCEPT A COMPLAINT FILED ON A  
12 DIFFERENT FORM IF THE COMPLAINT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS  
13 SECTION."
- 14 Page 5, before line 8 insert:  
15 "**SECTION 3. Appropriation.** (1) For the 2024-25 state fiscal  
16 year, \$136,122 is appropriated to the judicial department for use by courts  
17 administration. This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement  
18 this act, the department may use this appropriation as follows:  
19 (a) \$128,922 for general courts administration, which amount is  
20 based on an assumption that the department will require an additional 0.9  
21 FTE; and

1 (b) \$7,200 for capital outlay."

2 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

3 Page 1, line 103, strike "PUBLIC." and substitute "PUBLIC, AND, IN  
4 CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION."

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
