Bill Summary

Under current law, a "head of a family" is allowed to brew beer for family use without obtaining a liquor license. The bill deletes the

terminology "head of a family" and "family use" and replaces it with "adult" and "personal use".

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-47-106, amend 3 (2) (a) as follows: 4 12-47-106. Exemptions. (2) (a) NOTWITHSTANDING any provision of this article or article 46 of this title to the contrary, 5 6 notwithstanding, when permitted by federal law and rules and regulations 7 promulgated pursuant thereto, a head of a family AN ADULT may produce, 8 for family PERSONAL use and not for sale, such AN amount of fermented 9 malt beverage or malt or vinous liquor as EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT THAT 10 is exempt from the federal excise tax on such THE alcohol beverage when 11 produced by a head of a family AN ADULT for family PERSONAL use and 12 not for sale. SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, 13 14 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate

15 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
