# An Act

HOUSE BILL 16-1171

CONCERNING CONTINUATION OF THE COLORADO SPECIAL EDUCATION FISCAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-20-114.5, **amend** (2) (c) as follows:

**22-20-114.5. Special education fiscal advisory committee - special education high-cost grants - definitions.** (2) (c) This subsection (2) is repealed, effective ~~July 1, 2016.~~ ~~Prior to~~ SEPTEMBER 1, 2021. BEFORE its repeal, the committee ~~shall be reviewed as provided in~~ IS SCHEDULED FOR REVIEW IN ACCORDANCE WITH section 2-3-1203, C.R.S.

**SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, **repeal** (3) (cc) (I); and **add** (3) (hh.5) (II) as follows:

**2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees.** (3) The following dates are the dates on which the statutory authorization for the
