## **Bill Summary**

**Joint Budget Committee.** The peace officers standards and training board (P.O.S.T. board) currently provides a training curriculum for peace officers to recognize and address incidents of abuse and exploitation of persons 70 years of age and older. The bill requires the P.O.S.T. board to provide a similar training curriculum on abuse and

exploitation of persons 18 years of age and older who have an intellectual and developmental disability.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 1 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 24-31-313.5 as 3 follows: 4 24-31-313.5. Training concerning abuse and exploitation of 5 at-risk adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities. ON OR 6 BEFORE JUNE 30, 2016, THE P.O.S.T. BOARD SHALL CREATE AND 7 IMPLEMENT A TRAINING CURRICULUM TO PREPARE PEACE OFFICERS TO 8 RECOGNIZE AND ADDRESS INCIDENTS OF ABUSE AND EXPLOITATION OF 9 AT-RISK ADULTS WITH INTELLECTUAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES, 10 AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 18-6.5-102 (2.5) AND (10), C.R.S. 11 **SECTION 2.** No appropriation. The general assembly has 12 determined that this act can be implemented within existing 13 appropriations, including appropriations pursuant to section 39-28.8-501 14 (2) (b) (IV) (F), Colorado Revised Statutes, and therefore no separate 15 appropriation of state money is necessary to carry out the purposes of this 16 act. 17 **SECTION 3.** Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, 18 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 19 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
