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**BILL TOPIC:** MOTOR VEHICLE SERVICE CONTRACT PRODUCTS AND SERVICES

### Summary of Legislation

The bill authorizes the following products or services to be offered in connection with a motor vehicle service contract which is given for consideration over and above the lease or purchase price of a motor vehicle:

- repair or replacement of wheels or tires damaged by road hazards;
- paintless dent repair;
- repair or replacement of a windshield damaged by road hazards;
- key fob replacement; and
- other similar services.

The bill clarifies that a prepaid routine maintenance agreement is not a service or insurance contract. It also defines the term "manufacturer" as it applies to motor vehicle service contract insurance.

### Assessment

The bill does not change the revenue or expenditures for any agency of state or local government. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

### Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on May 4, 2016, and takes effect August 10, 2016, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
