

## BILL TOPIC: CORRECTION STATEMENT SEC STATE ERRONEOUS FILED DOC

Minimal workload increase.				
Appropriation Required: None.				
Future Year Impacts: Minimal ongoing workload increase.				
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### Summary of Legislation

Under current law, an entity may file a statement of correction with the Secretary of State's Office (SOS) to revoke a previously filed document under certain conditions. This bill allows statements of correction to also be filed for a document that was delivered and filed in error.

#### State Expenditures

This bill increases SOS workload by a minimal amount to process any statement of correction received for a document that was filed in error. This workload increase can be accomplished within existing appropriations.

#### **Effective Date**

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on June 6, 2016, and takes effect August 10, 2016, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
