**Summary of Legislation**

This bill updates statutory references concerning a person's immigration status. Under current law, the terms alien or illegal alien are used; this bill replaces those terms with the term undocumented immigrant. The bill defines an undocumented immigrant as a person who is not a United States citizen and who is residing or present in the United States without official documents that authorize that person to enter, live in, or work in the country.

**State Expenditures**

The bill creates a very minimal workload impact for state agencies that may have to update contracts, forms, and other documents. No increases in appropriations are required for any state agency.

**Local Government Impact**

Similar to state agencies, local governments may have minimal workload increases to update contracts, forms, and other documents.

**Effective Date**

The bill was postponed indefinitely by the Senate State, Veterans, and Military Affairs Committee on April 18, 2016.
