BILL TOPIC: MUNICIPAL STATE HIGHWAY OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES

Summary of Legislation

Under current law, an operator of an off-highway vehicle (OHV) may cross a state highway at an at-grade crossing, except within the jurisdiction of a municipality. This bill gives authority to municipalities to allow OHV operators to cross state highways within the jurisdiction of the municipality.

Local Government Impact

To the extent that municipalities authorize OHV operators to cross state highways within their jurisdiction, they may experience a minimal increase in workload to adopt policies and guidance specifying where and how operators may cross highways. Municipalities that decide to maintain the practice as unlawful could also incur minimal costs to specify this.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
