Status

This research note reflects the final version of the bill, which became effective on August 10, 2016.

Summary

This bill allows statements of correction to also be filed for a document that was delivered and filed in error.

Background

Under current law, an entity may file a statement of correction with the Secretary of State's Office to revoke a previously filed document under certain conditions.

House Action

House Business Affairs and Labor Committee (April 7, 2016). At the hearing, representatives from the Colorado Bar Association and Secretary of State's Office testified in support of the bill. The committee referred the bill, unamended, to the House Committee of the Whole.

House second reading (April 13, 2016). The House passed the bill, unamended, on second reading.
