After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB16-1324 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend the Health, Insurance, and Environment Committee Report, dated
2 March 17, 2016, strike page 1.

3 Page 2 of the committee report, strike lines 1 through 7 and substitute:

4 "Amend printed bill, page 2, line 20, strike "DISPENSED." and substitute
5 "DISPENSED, BUT ONLY".

6 Page 2 of the committee report, strike lines 11 through 17 and substitute
7 "IN THE STATE OF RESIDENCE AND A COPY OF THE MOST RECENT
8 INSPECTION RECEIVED FROM A BOARD-APPROVED THIRD-PARTY ENTITY
9 THAT INSPECTS PHARMACY OUTLETS, FOR WHICH THIRD-PARTY
10 INSPECTION THE NONRESIDENT PHARMACY OUTLET SHALL OBTAIN AND
11 PAY FOR ON AN ANNUAL BASIS, AND THE BOARD APPROVES THE
12 INSPECTION REPORTS AS SATISFACTORILY DEMONSTRATING PROOF OF
13 COMPLIANCE WITH THE BOARD'S OWN INSPECTION PROCEDURE AND
14 STANDARDS.

15 Page 3 of the bill, strike lines 5 and 6 and substitute "DRUG OUTLET MAY
16 COMPOUND AND DISTRIBUTE A DRUG TO A".

17 Page 3 of the bill, strike lines 16 and 17 and substitute "THROUGH A
18 REGISTERED PRESCRIPTION DRUG OUTLET".

1 Page 3 of the bill, after line 20 insert:

2 "(3) A LICENSED VETERINARIAN SHALL NOT ADMINISTER OR
3 DISPENSE A COMPOUNDED DRUG MAINTAINED FOR OFFICE STOCK
4 PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION OR FOR OFFICE USE PURSUANT TO SECTION
5 12-42.5-118(6)(b)(II) WITHOUT A VALID VETERINARIAN-CLIENT-PATIENT
6 RELATIONSHIP IN PLACE AT THE TIME OF ADMINISTERING THE
7 COMPOUNDED DRUG TO AN ANIMAL PATIENT OR DISPENSING THE
8 COMPOUNDED DRUG TO A CLIENT.

9 (4) TO COMPOUND AND DISTRIBUTE A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE
10 PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION OR SECTION 12-42.5-118 (6) (b) (II), A
11 REGISTERED PRESCRIPTION DRUG OUTLET SHALL POSSESS A VALID
12 MANUFACTURING REGISTRATION FROM THE FEDERAL DRUG ENFORCEMENT
13 ADMINISTRATION."

14 Renumber succeeding subsections accordingly.

15 Page 4 of the bill, strike lines 1 and 2 and substitute "PRESCRIPTION DRUG
16 OUTLET TO A VETERINARIAN;"

17 Page 4 of the bill, strike lines 7 and 8 and substitute:

18 "(c) "PATIENT" MEANS A COMPANION ANIMAL, AS THAT TERM IS
19 DEFINED BY RULE BY THE BOARD OF VETERINARY MEDICINE, IN
20 CONSULTATION WITH THE BOARD OF PHARMACY."."

21 Page 2 of the committee report, strike lines 27 through 32 and substitute
22 "PHARMACEUTICALS IN THE STATE OF RESIDENCE AND A COPY OF THE
23 MOST RECENT INSPECTION RECEIVED FROM A BOARD-APPROVED
24 THIRD-PARTY ENTITY THAT INSPECTS PHARMACY OUTLETS, FOR WHICH
25 THIRD-PARTY INSPECTION THE NONRESIDENT PHARMACY OUTLET SHALL
26 OBTAIN AND PAY FOR ON AN ANNUAL BASIS, AND THE BOARD APPROVES
27 THE INSPECTION REPORTS AS SATISFACTORILY DEMONSTRATING PROOF OF
28 COMPLIANCE WITH THE BOARD'S OWN INSPECTION PROCEDURE AND
29 STANDARDS.

30 Page 4 of the bill, strike lines 15 and 16 and substitute:

31 "(6) THE BOARD MAY PROMULGATE RULES AS NECESSARY

1 CONCERNING COMPOUNDED VETERINARY PHARMACEUTICALS PURSUANT
2 TO THIS SECTION AND SECTION 12-42.5-118 (6) (b) (II)."

3 Page 4 of the bill, line 26, strike "(3)" and substitute "(5)".

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
