Bill Summary

Transportation Legislation Review Committee. The bill amends the definition of autocycle to explicitly exclude motorcycles, clarify that the driver and each passenger in an autocycle ride in either a fully or a

HOUSE Amended 2nd Reading February 6, 2017 partly enclosed seating area, and eliminate the requirements that an autocycle be equipped with air bags and a hardtop enclosure that protects occupants from the elements and can support the weight of the vehicle without harming occupants when the vehicle is resting on the enclosure. The bill also amends the definitions of "motor vehicle" used in the laws governing mandatory safety belt and child restraint system use to clarify that those laws apply to autocycles.

2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-1-102, amend
3	(7.5) AND (55) as follows:
4	42-1-102. Definitions. As used in articles 1 to 4 of this title,
5	unless the context otherwise requires:
6	(7.5) "Autocycle" means a three-wheeled motor vehicle
7	MOTORCYCLE THAT DOES NOT USE HANDLEBARS OR ANY OTHER DEVICE
8	THAT IS DIRECTLY CONNECTED TO A SINGLE FRONT WHEEL TO STEER AND
9	in which the driver and each passenger rides RIDE in an A FULLY OR
10	PARTLY enclosed seating area that is equipped with: WITH SAFETY BELTS
11	FOR ALL OCCUPANTS THAT CONSTITUTE A SAFETY BELT SYSTEM, AS
12	DEFINED IN SECTION 42-4-237 (1)(b). FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION
13	(7.5), "PARTLY ENCLOSED SEATING AREA" MEANS A SEATING AREA THAT
14	IS ENTIRELY OR PARTLY SURROUNDED ON THE SIDES BY THE FRAME OR
15	BODY OF A VEHICLE BUT IS NOT FULLY ENCLOSED.
16	(a) Safety belts for all occupants that comply with section
17	42-4-237.
18	(b) Air bag protection; and
19	(c) A hardtop enclosure that protects occupants from the elements
20	and that supports the vehicle's weight without harming the occupants
21	when the vehicle is resting on the enclosure.
22	(55) "Motorcycle" means AN AUTOCYCLE OR a motor vehicle that

12	less than ten thousand pounds. "Motor vehicle" does not include
13	motorcycles THAT ARE NOT AUTOCYCLES, low-power scooters,
14	motorscooters, motorbicycles, motorized bicycles, and farm tractors and
15	implements of husbandry designed primarily or exclusively for use in
16	agricultural operations.
17	SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-4-237, amend
18	(1)(b) and (2) as follows:
19	42-4-237. Safety belt systems - mandatory use - exemptions -
20	penalty. (1) As used in this section:
21	(b) "Safety belt system" means a system utilizing a lap belt, a
22	shoulder belt, or any other belt or combination of belts installed in a
23	motor vehicle OR AN AUTOCYCLE to restrain drivers and passengers,
24	which system conforms to federal motor vehicle safety standards.
25	(2) Unless exempted pursuant to subsection (3) of this section,
26	every driver of and every front seat passenger in a motor vehicle AND
27	EVERY DRIVER OF AND EVERY PASSENGER IN AN AUTOCYCLE equipped

- with a safety belt system shall wear a fastened safety belt while the motor

- 3 **SECTION 4. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
- 4 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
