Bill Summary

The bill requires a health insurance carrier to offer and issue a catastrophic health insurance plan to eligible individuals who are under 30 years of age in certain geographic rating areas for a minimum of 3 years.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 10-16-105, add (9)
3 as follows:

4 10-16-105. Rate filing regulation - benefits ratio - catastrophic 5 plans - rules - definitions. (9) (a) A CARRIER THAT OFFERS AN 6 INDIVIDUAL HEALTH BENEFIT PLAN IN THE EAST GEOGRAPHIC RATING 7 AREA, THE WEST GEOGRAPHIC RATING AREA, OR GEOGRAPHIC RATING 8 AREA FIVE SHALL OFFER A CATASTROPHIC PLAN FOR A MINIMUM OF THREE 9 YEARS IN THESE AREAS AND SHALL ISSUE A CATASTROPHIC PLAN TO ANY 10 ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUAL RESIDING IN THE GEOGRAPHIC RATING AREA WHO 11 APPLIES FOR THE CATASTROPHIC PLAN AND AGREES TO THE REQUIRED 12 PREMIUM PAYMENTS.

(b) FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION (9):

(I) "EAST GEOGRAPHIC RATING AREA" MEANS ALAMOSA, BACA,
BENT, CHAFFEE, CHEYENNE, CONEJOS, COSTILLA, CROWLEY, CUSTER, EL
PASO, FREMONT, HUERFANO, KIOWA, KIT CARSON, LAS ANIMAS,
LINCOLN, LOGAN, MINERAL, MORGAN, OTERO, PHILLIPS, PROWERS, RIO
GRANDE, SAGUACHE, SEDGEWICK, TELLER, WASHINGTON, AND YUMA
COUNTIES.

20 (II) "GEOGRAPHIC RATING AREA FIVE" MEANS MESA COUNTY.

(III) "WEST GEOGRAPHIC RATING AREA" MEANS ARCHULETA,
DELTA, DOLORES, EAGLE, HINSDALE, GARFIELD, GRAND, GUNNISON,
JACKSON, LAKE, LA PLATA, MOFFAT, MONTEZUMA, MONTROSE, OURAY,
PITKIN, RIO BLANCO, ROUTT, SAN JUAN, SAN MIGUEL, AND SUMMIT
COUNTIES.

26 **SECTION 2.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act

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takes effect January 1, 2018; except that, if a referendum petition is filed 1 2 pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this 3 act or an item, section, or part of this act within the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly, then the act, item, 4 5 section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the 6 general election to be held in November 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on January 1, 2019, or on the date of the official declaration of the 7 8 vote thereon by the governor, whichever is later.
