A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING RULE-MAKING BY THE STATE ENGINEER REGARDING PERMITS FOR THE USE OF WATER ARTIFICIALLY RECHARGED

103 INTO NONTRIBUTARY GROUNDWATER AQUIFERS.

Bill Summary

Currently, the state engineer must promulgate rules for the permitting and use of waters artificially recharged into 4 named aquifers. The bill adds the requirement that the state engineer also promulgate rules for the permitting and use of waters artificially recharged into nontributary groundwater aquifers. The rules must be promulgated on or

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 37-90-137, amend 3 (9)(d) as follows: 4 37-90-137. Permits to construct wells outside designated 5 basins - fees - permit no groundwater right - evidence - time 6 **limitation - well permits - rules.** (9) (d) On or before July 1, 1995, the 7 state engineer shall promulgate reasonable rules which shall THAT apply 8 to the permitting and use of waters WATER artificially recharged into the 9 Dawson, Denver, Arapahoe, and Laramie-Fox Hills aquifers. ON OR 10 BEFORE JULY 1, 2018, THE STATE ENGINEER SHALL PROMULGATE RULES 11 THAT APPLY TO THE PERMITTING AND USE OF WATER ARTIFICIALLY 12 RECHARGED INTO A NONTRIBUTARY GROUNDWATER AQUIFER. The rules 13 shall PROMULGATED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (9)(d) MUST 14 effectuate the maximum utilization of these aquifers through the 15 conjunctive use of surface and groundwater resources. 16 **SECTION 2.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 17 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 18 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 19 9, 2017, if adjournment sine die is on May 10, 2017); except that, if a 20 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 21 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 22 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect 23 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 24 November 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 25 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
