101	CONCERNING PEACE OFFICER DESIGNATION FOR THE MANAGER OF THE
102	OFFICE OF PREVENTION AND SECURITY WITHIN THE DIVISION OF

104	DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY.

Bill Summary

The bill designates as a peace officer the manager of the office of prevention and security within the division of homeland security and emergency management in the department of public safety.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 16-2.5-112.5 as
3	follows:
4	16-2.5-112.5. Manager of the office of prevention and security
5	within the division of homeland security and emergency
6	management. The manager of the office of prevention and
7	SECURITY WITHIN THE DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY
8	MANAGEMENT IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY IS A PEACE OFFICER
9	WHOSE AUTHORITY INCLUDES THE ENFORCEMENT OF ALL LAWS OF THE
10	STATE OF COLORADO AND WHO MAY BE CERTIFIED BY THE P.O.S.T.
11	BOARD.
12	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-1606,
13	amend (1) as follows:
14	24-33.5-1606. Office of prevention and security - creation -
15	duties. (1) (a) There is hereby created within the division an office of
16	prevention and security, the head of which is the manager of the office of
17	prevention and security. The director shall appoint the manager of the
18	office of prevention and security pursuant to section 13 of article XII of
19	the state constitution.
20	(b) THE MANAGER OF THE OFFICE OF PREVENTION AND SECURITY
21	IS HEREBY DESIGNATED TO BE A PEACE OFFICER AND HAS JURISDICTION TO
22	ACT AS SUCH IN THE PERFORMANCE OF HIS OR HER DUTIES ANYWHERE
23	WITHIN THE STATE AND IS ENTITLED TO ALL PROTECTIONS, DEFENSES, AND
24	IMMUNITIES PROVIDED BY STATUTE TO SAFEGUARD A PEACE OFFICER IN
25	THE PERFORMANCE OF OFFICIAL ACTS.
26	SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act

takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 1 2 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 3 9, 2017, if adjournment sine die is on May 10, 2017); except that, if a 4 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 5 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 6 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect 7 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 8 November 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor. 9
