A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATUTORY DEFINITION OF A CONSTRUCTION DEFECT FOR PURPOSES OF THE "CONSTRUCTION DEFECT ACTION REFORM ACT".

Bill Summary

The bill separately defines and clarifies the term "construction defect" in the "Construction Defect Action Reform Act".

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 13-20-802.5, amend
3	(1); and add (3.5) as follows:
4	13-20-802.5. Definitions. As used in this part 8, unless the
5	context otherwise requires:
6	(1) "Action" means a civil action or an arbitration proceeding for
7	damages, indemnity, or contribution brought against a construction
8	professional to assert a claim, counterclaim, cross-claim, or third-party
9	claim for damages or loss to, or the loss of use of, real or personal
10	property or personal injury caused by a defect in the design or
11	construction of an improvement to real property BASED ON A
12	CONSTRUCTION DEFECT.
13	(3.5) "CONSTRUCTION DEFECT" MEANS A DEFECT IN THE DESIGN OR
14	CONSTRUCTION OF ANY IMPROVEMENT TO REAL PROPERTY THAT CAUSES:
15	(a) ANY DAMAGES TO, OR THE LOSS OF USE OF, REAL OR PERSONAL
16	PROPERTY; OR
17	(b) PERSONAL INJURY.
18	SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
19	takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
20	ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
21	9, 2017, if adjournment sine die is on May 10, 2017); except that, if a
22	referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
23	state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
24	within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
25	unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
26	November 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
27	official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
