Summary of Legislation

This bill recommended by the **Statutory Revision Committee**, repeals the annual report on the operation of the Uniform Commercial Code (UCC) filing office in the Department of State. Under current law, this report is required to be prepared annually and is provided to the Governor and the General Assembly by June 30.

State Expenditures

Beginning in the current fiscal year, FY 2016-17, the bill decreases workload in the Department of State by a minimal amount by repealing the UCC filing office report. This report takes less than five hours of staff time and no other costs are incurred; therefore no change in appropriations is required.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on March 23, 2017.
