**BILL TOPIC:** STATUTORY REVISION COMMITTEE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF  
EDUCATION TITLE 22 CORRECTIONS

**Summary of Legislation**

This bill modifies a statutory reference in Title 22 related to the October pupil count date for school finance in order to conform with other statutory references. The bill also deletes statutory references to "accredited independent school" and "accredited nonpublic school", since the State Board of Education does not accredit either type of school.

**Assessment**

The bill cleans up language in state statute to conform references to the October student count date and eliminates obsolete definitions and references related to accreditation. Neither of these provisions will change the workload, expenditures, or revenue of any state agency, school district, or local government. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

**Effective Date**

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on March 1, 2017, and became effective on August 9, 2017.
