BILL TOPIC: MODERNIZE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH TERMINOLOGY IN CRS

Summary of Legislation

This bill updates terminology in state law related to behavioral health, mental health, alcohol abuse, and substance abuse to recognize them as specific types of disorders. It also corrects statutory references to the Office of Behavioral Health in the Department of Human Services.

Assessment

This bill does not alter the workload, revenue, or expenditures of any state agency or local government and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
