AN ACT

**CONCERNING AN EXTENSION OF THE SCHEDULED REPEAL DATE FOR UNIFORM COMMERCIAL CODE
FILING FEES TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE COLORADO FRAUD INVESTIGATORS UNIT.**

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-1704, **amend** (7) as follows:

24-33.5-1704. Colorado fraud investigators unit - creation - duties - repeal.

(7) (a) Beginning in 2014, and every year thereafter through ~~2017~~ 2020, the department of public safety shall report on the activities of the unit as part of its "State Measurement for Accountable, Responsive, and Transparent (SMART) Government Act" hearing required by section 2-7-203. ~~C.R.S.~~

(b) This subsection (7) is repealed, effective ~~July 1, 2018~~ JULY 1, 2021.

SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-1707, **amend** (2)(a)(I)(B) as follows:

24-33.5-1707. Funding - cash fund created - donations - repeal.

(2) (a) (I) (B) Notwithstanding ~~the provisions of sub-subparagraph (A) of this subparagraph (I)~~ SUBSECTION (2)(a)(I)(A) OF THIS SECTION, from July 1, 2014, through ~~June 30, 2017~~ JUNE 30, 2020, the surcharge is four dollars. This ~~sub-subparagraph (B)~~ SUBSECTION (2)(a)(I)(B) is repealed, effective ~~July 1, 2018~~ JULY 1, 2021.

Capital letters indicate new material added to existing statutes; dashes through words indicate deletions from existing statutes and such material not part of act.

SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
