After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB17-1158 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 9, strike line 1 and substitute "(1)(a), (1)(b), and
2 (1)(c) as follows:".

3 Page 9, strike lines 11 through 15 and substitute:

4 "(b) The secretary of state provides sufficient notification under
5 this section if the secretary:

6 (I) ~~gives~~ MAILS at least two notices BY FIRST-CLASS MAIL to the
7 ~~organization and registered agent of~~ ADDRESS OF RECORD FOR the
8 charitable organization, professional fundraising consultant, or paid
9 solicitor; AND

10 (II) IF THE CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION, PROFESSIONAL
11 FUNDRAISING CONSULTANT, OR PAID SOLICITOR HAS PROVIDED THE
12 SECRETARY WITH AN E-MAIL ADDRESS, SENDS AT LEAST TWO NOTICES TO
13 THAT E-MAIL ADDRESS.

14 (c) The fine for filing a registration renewal, FINANCIAL REPORT
15 REQUIRED BY SECTION 6-16-104 (2)(f), (4)(b), OR (5), or solicitation
16 campaign financial report late must not exceed one hundred dollars per
17 year for charities or two hundred dollars per year for paid solicitors;
18 EXCEPT THAT A CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION THAT FAILS TO TIMELY
19 RENEW ITS REGISTRATION AND FAILS TO FILE THE FINANCIAL REPORT
20 REQUIRED BY SECTION 6-16-104 (5) IS ONLY SUBJECT TO A SINGLE FINE
21 FOR THE FAILURE TO RENEW ITS REGISTRATION."

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
