After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB17-193 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 4, strike "**prevention strategies for**".
- 2 Page 2, strike line 5.
- 3 Page 2, line 6, strike "**controlled substances - "** and substitute
- 4 "**substance use disorder prevention, treatment, and recovery support**
- 5 **strategies - "**.
- 6 Page 2, line 21, strike "COLORADO," and substitute "COLORADO;".
- 7 Page 2, strike lines 22 and 23.
- 8 Page 3, line 3, strike "2014." and substitute "2014;
- 9 (e) COLORADO AND OTHER STATES IN THE REGION HAVE THE
- 10 HIGHEST DEATH RATES ATTRIBUTABLE TO ALCOHOL IN THE COUNTRY, AND
- 11 APPROXIMATELY EIGHTEEN PERCENT, OR ONE OUT OF EVERY FIVE, OF ALL
- 12 COLORADO ADULTS ENGAGED IN HEAVY OR BINGE DRINKING MONTHLY;
- 13 (f) IN ADDITION TO OPIOIDS, PRESCRIPTION DRUGS, AND ALCOHOL,
- 14 SURVEYS SHOW USE RATES FOR METHAMPHETAMINE, COCAINE, AND OTHER
- 15 ILLICIT DRUGS ARE HIGHER IN COLORADO THAN IN OTHER STATES; AND
- 16 (g) THERE IS A LACK OF SUFFICIENT RESEARCH ON THE MOST
- 17 EFFECTIVE STRATEGIES FOR ADDRESSING SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS
- 18 ACROSS THE FULL CONTINUUM OF RECOMMENDED SERVICES THAT INCLUDE
- 19 PREVENTION, EARLY INTERVENTION, TREATMENT, AND RECOVERY

- 1 SUPPORT SERVICES."
- 2 Page 3, strike lines 8 and 9 and substitute "SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER
3 PREVENTION, TREATMENT, AND RECOVERY SUPPORT STRATEGIES."
- 4 Page 3, line 10, strike "PREVENTION STRATEGIES FOR,".
- 5 Page 3, strike line 11.
- 6 Page 3, line 12, strike "CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES, AND ALCOHOL," and
7 substitute "SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER PREVENTION, TREATMENT, AND
8 RECOVERY SUPPORT STRATEGIES,".
- 9 Page 3, strike lines 16 through 23 and substitute:
10 "(a) ESTABLISH OR EXPAND PROGRAMS FOR RESEARCH
11 CONCERNING PREVENTION, TREATMENT, AND RECOVERY SUPPORT
12 STRATEGIES FOR SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED
13 TO OPIOID ADDICTION;
14 (b) ESTABLISH OR EXPAND INNOVATIVE TREATMENTS FOR
15 SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO OPIOID
16 ADDICTION;
17 (c) EXPAND PARTNERSHIPS AND COLLABORATION WITH SUBSTANCE
18 USE DISORDER PROFESSIONALS, OTHER PROGRAMS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF
19 COLORADO, AND OTHER ORGANIZATIONS WITH SIMILAR MISSIONS
20 THROUGHOUT THE STATE AND NATION; AND".
- 21 Page 3, line 25, after "CENTER'S" insert "RESEARCH".
- 22 Page 1, strike lines 102 through 104 and substitute "**INTO SUBSTANCE USE
23 DISORDER PREVENTION, TREATMENT, AND RECOVERY SUPPORT
24 STRATEGIES" AT THE UNIVERSITY OF**".
