After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and
 substitute:

"SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add article 22.5 to 3 4 title 10 as follows: 5 **ARTICLE 22.5** 6 **Colorado High-risk Health Care Coverage Study** 7 **10-22.5-101.** Short title. The short title of this article 22.5 8 IS THE "COLORADO HIGH-RISK HEALTH CARE COVERAGE STUDY ACT". 9 **10-22.5-102. Legislative declaration.** THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY 10 HEREBY DECLARES THAT, WITH RISING RATES IN THE INDIVIDUAL HEALTH 11 INSURANCE MARKET AND POTENTIAL MODIFICATIONS TO FEDERAL LAW 12 THAT MAY IMPACT THE INDIVIDUAL HEALTH INSURANCE MARKET IN 13 COLORADO AND ACCESS TO HEALTH CARE COVERAGE BY INDIVIDUALS 14 THAT ARE HIGH RISK DUE TO A MEDICAL CONDITION, IT IS IMPORTANT FOR 15 COLORADO TO BE IN A POSITION TO UNDERSTAND AND PROACTIVELY 16 RESPOND TO FUTURE FEDERAL PROGRAMS AND GUIDANCE THAT MAY BE 17 ENACTED WHILE THE COLORADO GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS NOT IN SESSION. 18 ACCORDINGLY, THE PURPOSE OF THIS ARTICLE 22.5 IS TO AUTHORIZE THE 19 COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE AND THE DIVISION OF INSURANCE TO STUDY 20 WAYS TO PROVIDE ACCESS TO HEALTH CARE COVERAGE FOR THOSE 21 COLORADO RESIDENTS WHO ARE CONSIDERED HIGH RISK BECAUSE OF A 22 MEDICAL CONDITION AND TO EXAMINE WAYS TO REDUCE HEALTH 23 INSURANCE PREMIUMS IN THE INDIVIDUAL HEALTH INSURANCE MARKET. 24 10-22.5-103. Definitions. As used in this article 22.5, UNLESS

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<u>SB17-300</u> be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 THE CONTEXT OTHERWISE REQUIRES:

2 (1) "CARRIER" HAS THE SAME MEANING AS SET FORTH IN SECTION
3 10-16-102 (8).

4 (2) "COMMISSIONER" MEANS THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE 5 OR THE COMMISSIONER'S DESIGNEE.

6 (3) "DIVISION" MEANS THE DIVISION OF INSURANCE ESTABLISHED 7 IN SECTION 10-1-103.

8 (4) "FEDERAL ACT" MEANS THE "PATIENT PROTECTION AND 9 AFFORDABLE CARE ACT", PUB.L. 111-148, AS AMENDED BY THE "HEALTH 10 CARE AND EDUCATION RECONCILIATION ACT OF 2010", PUB.L. 111-152, 11 AND AS MAY BE FURTHER AMENDED, AND INCLUDING ANY FEDERAL 12 REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THE FEDERAL ACT.

13 (5) "HIGH-RISK INDIVIDUAL" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS A
14 MEDICAL CONDITION THAT IS LIKELY TO RESULT IN HIGH HEALTH CARE
15 COSTS.

16 (6) "REINSURANCE" MEANS THE ASSUMPTION OF ALL OR PART OF17 A RISK UNDERTAKEN ORIGINALLY BY AN INSURER.

18 10-22.5-104. High-risk health care coverage study commissioner to conduct - report. (1) THE COMMISSIONER SHALL
STUDY METHODS OF PROVIDING HEALTH CARE COVERAGE TO HIGH-RISK
INDIVIDUALS AND REDUCING HEALTH INSURANCE PREMIUMS IN THE
INDIVIDUAL MARKET. IN CONDUCTING THE STUDY, THE COMMISSIONER
AND THE DIVISION SHALL ENGAGE WITH AND SEEK ONGOING INPUT FROM
CARRIERS, CONSUMER GROUPS, AND OTHER INTERESTED STAKEHOLDERS.

(2) AS PART OF THE STUDY, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL EXPLORE
THE FEASIBILITY OF PROVIDING HEALTH CARE COVERAGE FOR HIGH-RISK
INDIVIDUALS AND REDUCING PREMIUMS THROUGH A HIGH-RISK POOL,
REINSURANCE PROGRAM, OR OTHER HIGH-RISK PROGRAMS, AND SHALL
TAKE INTO CONSIDERATION:

30 (a) ANY REQUIREMENTS IMPOSED UNDER THE FEDERAL ACT OR
31 OTHER APPLICABLE FEDERAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS TO QUALIFY FOR
32 FEDERAL FINANCIAL SUPPORT;

33 (b) POTENTIAL FINANCIAL IMPACTS TO CONSUMERS AND THE
 34 BUSINESS COMMUNITY;

35 (c) POTENTIAL FUNDING MECHANISMS AND OTHER MEASURES TO
 36 ENSURE THE LONG-TERM FINANCIAL SUSTAINABILITY OF A HIGH-RISK OR
 37 REINSURANCE PROGRAM; AND

38 (d) THE NECESSARY PROCEDURAL REQUIREMENTS THAT THE STATE
39 MUST FULFILL IN ORDER TO APPLY FOR AND SEEK APPROVAL OF ANY
40 WAIVER OR OTHER AUTHORIZATION THAT MAY BE REQUIRED UNDER THE
41 FEDERAL ACT OR OTHER APPLICABLE FEDERAL LAW.

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1 (3) (a) UPON COMPLETION OF THE STUDY, THE COMMISSIONER 2 SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT ON THE STUDY TO THE JOINT BUDGET COMMITTEE 3 OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES 4 COMMITTEE OF THE SENATE, AND THE HEALTH, INSURANCE, AND 5 ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, OR THEIR 6 SUCCESSOR COMMITTEES, BY OCTOBER 1, 2017, WHICH REPORT MAY BE 7 CONSIDERED, AS NECESSARY, IN THE BUDGETING PROCESS. THE 8 COMMISSIONER SHALL REPORT, AT A MINIMUM, ON THE AREAS INCLUDED 9 IN THE STUDY, AS SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS SECTION.

10 (b) IN ADDITION TO SUBMITTING THE REPORT AS REQUIRED BY THIS 11 SUBSECTION (3), THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PRESENT THE REPORT TO THE 12 HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES COMMITTEE OF THE SENATE AND THE 13 HEALTH, INSURANCE, AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE OF THE HOUSE OF 14 REPRESENTATIVES, OR THEIR SUCCESSOR COMMITTEES, DURING THE 15 COMMITTEES' HEARINGS HELD PRIOR TO THE 2018 REGULAR SESSION UNDER THE "STATE MEASUREMENT FOR ACCOUNTABLE, RESPONSIVE, 16 AND TRANSPARENT (SMART) GOVERNMENT ACT", PART 2 OF ARTICLE 7 17 18 OF TITLE 2.

19 10-22.5-105. Gifts, grants, donations, and federal funding 20 authority to accept and expend. THE COMMISSIONER MAY SEEK, ACCEPT,
21 AND EXPEND GIFTS, GRANTS, DONATIONS FROM PRIVATE OR PUBLIC
22 SOURCES OR ANY FEDERAL FUNDING TO DEFRAY THE COSTS OF
23 CONDUCTING THE STUDY PURSUANT TO SECTION 10-22.5-104.

24 10-22.5-106. Repeal. THIS ARTICLE IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JUNE
25 30, 2018.

26 SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 27 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 28 29 9, 2017, if adjournment sine die is on May 10, 2017); except that, if a 30 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 31 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 32 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect 33 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 34 November 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 35 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.".

ISSUES RELATED TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SUCH PROGRAMS.".

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
