If an institution of higher education admits as a junior a transfer student who holds an associate of arts degree, associate of applied science degree, or an associate of science degree that is the subject of a statewide degree transfer agreement, and the institution requires the student to complete additional lower-division general education courses in order to complete the baccalaureate degree, the institution is responsible for the

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

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2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 23-1-108, **amend** 3 (7)(b)(II) as follows:

23-1-108. Duties and powers of the commission with regard to systemwide planning - reporting - definitions. (7) (b) (II) (A) A state institution of higher education that admits as a junior a student who holds an associate of arts degree, associate of applied science degree, or associate of science degree that is the subject of a statewide degree transfer agreement may SHALL not require the student to complete any additional <u>credit hours of lower-division general education courses;</u> except that the institution may require the student to complete additional lower-division general education courses if necessary for preparation in the degree program in which the student enrolls so long as the additional courses are consistent with published degree program requirements for native students and do not extend the time to degree completion beyond that required for native students in the same degree program. COURSES TO FULFILL GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS. A STUDENT WHO TRANSFERS UNDER A STATEWIDE DEGREE TRANSFER AGREEMENT MAY BE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE LOWER-DIVISION COURSES THAT ARE PART OF THE MAJOR, BUT ARE NOT PART OF THE STATEWIDE DEGREE TRANSFER AGREEMENT, IF TAKING THE COURSES DOES NOT REQUIRE THE TRANSFER STUDENT TO TAKE MORE TOTAL CREDIT HOURS TO RECEIVE THE DEGREE THAN A NATIVE STUDENT AND DOES NOT EXTEND THE TOTAL TIME REQUIRED TO RECEIVE THE DEGREE BEYOND THAT REQUIRED FOR A NATIVE STUDENT. A STATE INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION THAT REQUIRES

7	CREDIT HOURS REQUIRED FOR A NATIVE STUDENT OR THAT EXTEND THE
8	TOTAL TIME TO RECEIVE THE DEGREE BEYOND THAT REQUIRED FOR A
9	NATIVE STUDENT. All credit hours of acceptable course work
10	completed by a student who holds an associate of applied science degree
11	that is the subject of a statewide degree transfer agreement and who
12	transfers from the state institution of higher education that awarded the
13	associate degree to a state four-year institution of higher education shall
14	be applicable only to a bachelor of applied science degree program,
15	except for courses that are subject to transfer pursuant to other transfer
16	agreements.
17	(B) NOTHING IN SUBSECTION (7)(b)(II)(A) OF THIS SECTION
18	ALTERS, AMENDS, CREATES, OR IMPOSES NEW REQUIREMENTS FOR
19	STATEWIDE DEGREE TRANSFER AGREEMENTS IN EFFECT PRIOR TO THE
20	EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBSECTION (7)(b)(II), AS AMENDED.
21	SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
22	takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
23	ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
24	8, 2018, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2018); except that, if a
25	referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
26	state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
27	within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect

- November 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
- 3 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

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
