# A BILL FOR AN ACT

## **Bill Summary**

Joint Budget Committee. The bill requires the state treasurer to transfer specified amounts from the general fund and the marijuana tax

cash fund to a newly created office of state planning and budgeting youth pay for success initiatives account within the pay for success contracts fund for state fiscal years 2018-19 through 2021-22. Subject to annual appropriation, the office of state planning and budgeting may expend the money transferred to the account for its use only to fund 3 specified pay for success contracts for pilot programs designed to reduce juvenile involvement in the justice system, reduce out-of-home placements of juveniles, and improve on-time high school graduation rates, but the department of human services may expend any money appropriated to it from the account for expenses related to the administration of any pay for success contract. For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$718,412 is appropriated from the account to the office of the governor for use by the office of state planning and budgeting, with \$52,511 of that amount being reappropriated to the department of human services for use by the division of youth services for personal services and operating expenses related to the administration of any pay for success contract.

- 2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-37-403, amend
- 3 (6) as follows:

24-37-403. Establishment of state pay for success contracts
program - pay for success contracts fund - creation. (6) (a) The pay
for success contracts fund is AND THE OFFICE OF STATE PLANNING AND
BUDGETING YOUTH PAY FOR SUCCESS INITIATIVES ACCOUNT OF THE FUND
ARE hereby created in the state treasury. The principal of the fund consists
AND THE PRINCIPAL OF THE ACCOUNT RESPECTIVELY CONSIST of:

- (I) Moneys MONEY appropriated or transferred to the fund OR THE
  ACCOUNT by the general assembly that have HAS become available or are
  IS expected to become available due to direct or indirect reductions in
  state spending resulting from the provision of program-eligible
  interventions programs under a contract entered into pursuant to
  subsection (2) of this section; and

(II) Any other money that the general assembly appropriates or

2 (b) Interest and income earned on the deposit and investment of 3 money in the fund is credited to the fund; EXCEPT THAT INTEREST AND 4 INCOME EARNED ON THE DEPOSIT AND INVESTMENT OF MONEY IN THE 5 ACCOUNT IS CREDITED TO THE ACCOUNT. Subject to annual appropriation 6 by the general assembly, the office shall expend moneys MONEY in the 7 fund AND IN THE ACCOUNT to make payments to the lead contractor as 8 required by a contract and to pay any administrative expenses incurred in 9 connection with a contract. 18 REDUCE JUVENILE INVOLVEMENT IN THE JUSTICE SYSTEM, REDUCE
19 OUT-OF-HOME PLACEMENTS OF JUVENILES, AND IMPROVE ON-TIME HIGH

27 **SECTION 3.** Appropriation. (1) For the 2018-19 state fiscal

year, \$718,412 is appropriated to the office of the governor for use by the
office of state planning and budgeting. This appropriation is from the
office of state planning and budgeting youth pay for success initiatives
account of the pay for success contracts fund created in section 24-37-403
(6)(a), C.R.S. To implement this act, the office may use this appropriation
for the state pay for success contracts program.

7 (2) For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$52,511 is appropriated to
8 the department of human services for use by the division of youth
9 services. This appropriation is from reappropriated funds received from
10 the office of the governor under subsection (1) of this section. To
11 implement this act, the division may use this appropriation as follows:

(a) \$47,341 for personal services related to the administration of
any pay for success contract implemented as authorized by the "Pay for
Success Contracts Act", part 4 of article 37 of title 24, C.R.S., which
amount is based on an assumption that the division will require an
additional 0.5 FTE; and

(b) \$5,170 for operating expenses related to the administration of
any pay for success contract implemented as authorized by the "Pay for
Success Contracts Act", part 4 of article 37 of title 24, C.R.S.

SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
