## **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates a total of \$1,175,226 General Fund, including: (1) \$1,019,110 to the Department of Education; and (2) \$156,116 to the Department of Higher Education. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department of Education will require an additional 0.3 FTE.

### **Points to Consider**

### General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2018-19 based on the March 2018 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its budget package \$8,000,000 General Fund set-aside for FY 2018-19 for Educator Preparation Programs in the Department of Education.
