The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates \$2,000,000 General Fund to the Public Safety Communications Trust Fund for FY 2018-19, and reappropriates \$2,000,000 to the Governor's Office of Information Technology for FY 2018-19 from the Public Safety Communications Trust Fund.
