SECTION 2. Appropriation to the department of military and veterans affairs for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018. In Session Laws of Colorado 2018, amend section 3 of chapter 191, (HB 18-1337), as follows:

Section 3. **Appropriation.** For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, \$123,465 \$180,890 is appropriated to the department of military and veterans affairs for use by the division of veterans affairs. This appropriation is from the general fund and is based on an assumption that the division will require an additional 1.1 FTE. To implement this act, the division may use this appropriation for the Grand Junction veterans one-stop center.
