SECTION 2. Appropriation to the department of military and
 veterans affairs for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018. In Session
 Laws of Colorado 2018, amend section 3 of chapter 191, (HB 18-1337),
 as follows:

5 Section 3. Appropriation. For the 2018-19 state fiscal year, 6 <del>\$123,465</del> \$180,890 is appropriated to the department of military and 7 veterans affairs for use by the division of veterans affairs. This 8 appropriation is from the general fund and is based on an assumption that 9 the division will require an additional 1.1 FTE. To implement this act, the 10 division may use this appropriation for the Grand Junction veterans 11 one-stop center.

SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
