11 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-1614, **repeal**
12 (3.3)(i) as follows:

15 **subcommittee - public safety communications subcommittee -**
16 **creation - definitions - repeal.** (3.3) (i) ~~This subsection (3.3) is repealed,~~
17 ~~effective September 1, 2019. Prior to repeal, the subcommittee shall be~~
18 ~~reviewed pursuant to section 2-3-1203, C.R.S.~~

19 **SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
20 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
21 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
22 2, 2019, if adjournment sine die is on May 3, 2019); except that, if a
23 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
24 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
25 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect

1 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
2 November 2020 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
3 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
