2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-109, **amend**
3 (9) as follows:

4 **24-33.5-109. Cold case task force - creation - rules - repeal.**

9 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-34-104, **repeal**
10 (17)(a)(V); and **add** (27)(a)(VIII) as follows:

12 **and functions for repeal, continuation, or reestablishment - legislative**
13 **declaration - repeal.** (17) (a) The following agencies, functions, or both,
14 are scheduled for repeal on September 1, 2019:

20 **SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
21 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
22 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
23 2, 2019, if adjournment sine die is on May 3, 2019); except that, if a
24 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
25 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act

1 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
2 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
3 November 2020 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
4 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
