102 **AN ELIGIBLE PERSON WITH A SPINAL CORD INJURY TO RECEIVE**
103 **COMPLEMENTARY OR ALTERNATIVE MEDICINE.**

Bill Summary

The bill continues the department of health care policy and financing's pilot program that allows an eligible person with a spinal cord injury to receive complementary or alternative medicine until 2025.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In 25.5-6-1303, **amend** (5) introductory portion as
3 follows:

4 **25.5-6-1303. Pilot program - complementary or alternative**
5 **medicine - rules.** (5) The state department shall cause to be conducted
6 an independent evaluation of the pilot program to be completed no later
7 than January 1, ~~2020~~ 2025. The state department shall provide a report of
8 the evaluation to the health and human services ~~committees~~ COMMITTEE
9 of the senate and THE PUBLIC HEALTH CARE AND HUMAN SERVICES
10 COMMITTEE OF the house of representatives, or any successor committees.
11 The report on the evaluation must include the following:

12 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 25.5-6-1304
13 as follows:

14 **25.5-6-1304. Repeal of part.** This part 13 is repealed, effective
15 September 1, ~~2020~~ 2025.

16 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
17 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
18 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
