Bill Topic: STATE STUDENT ADV COUNCIL MEMBER ELIGIBILITY

Summary of Fiscal Impact: **No fiscal impact.** The bill changes eligibility requirements for a student to serve on the student advisory council for community colleges.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the enacted bill.

Summary of Legislation

Under current law, the student advisory council to the State Board for Community Colleges and Occupational Education is comprised of resident (in-state) students. This bill removes the requirement that student members must be classified as an in-state student for tuition purposes in order to serve on the advisory council.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

Changing the eligibility requirement for participation on the advisory council has no impact on the workload, expenditures, or revenue of any state agency, local government, or on the community college system. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor and it took effect on March 28, 2019.
