Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$89,474 General Fund to the Legislative Department for FY 2019-20. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Legislative Department will require an additional 0.9 FTE to implement the act. While the Finance Committee Report authorizes the use of gifts, grants, and donations for implementation of the bill, no source of funds has been identified. Staff has thus prepared a General Fund appropriation clause for the Committee's consideration.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The general appropriations bill for FY 2019-20 has not yet been introduced. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$89,474 for FY 2019-20, reducing the amount of General Fund available for other purposes.
