**Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates \$57,242 cash funds from the Emergency Medical Services Account within the Highway Users Tax Fund to the Department of Public Health and Environment for FY 2019-20. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.8 FTE to implement the act.
