## **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

#### **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$239,592 from the Plant Health, Pest Control, and Environmental Protection Cash Fund to the Department of Agriculture for FY 2019-20. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.6 FTE. Of that amount: \$21,875 is reappropriated to the Department of Public Health and Environment and is based on the assumption the Department of Public Health and Environment will require 0.2 FTE; and \$1,000 is reappropriated to the Department of Personnel.
