**Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

**Points to Consider**

*TABOR/ Excess State Revenues Impact*

This bill creates the Front Range Waste Diversion Enterprise in the Department of Public Health and Environment as a Type 1 transfer. The Enterprise constitutes an enterprise for purposes of Section 20 of Article X of the State Constitution and its revenue will be exempt from TABOR.

## **JBC Staff Analysis**

### *Legislative Authority*

Is it necessary to "continuously appropriate" money in the Front Range Waste Diversion Cash Fund? This method of funding the activities of the Enterprise essentially moves related expenditures off-budget, and thus expenditures are not reported or accounted for through the budget process.
