money from the county general fund to the county road and bridge fund if the governor declares a disaster emergency in the applicable county. The transfers are allowed for 8 years following the date of the governor's declaration of a disaster in the county. The bill clarifies that the 8 years begins the day after the date of the governor's final declaration of an emergency for the disaster, including all extensions to the declaration.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 30-25-106, amend 3 (3) as follows: 4 **30-25-106.** Fund - purposes. (3) Notwithstanding the provisions 5 of subsection (1) of this section, the board of county commissioners is 6 authorized to transfer moneys MONEY from the county general fund to the 7 county road and bridge fund created in section 43-2-202 if the governor 8 declares, by executive order or proclamation, a disaster emergency in the 9 applicable county pursuant to section 24-33.5-704 (4). The board of 10 county commissioners is authorized to make the transfers until eight years 11 after the date of the governor's declaration of an emergency in the county. 12 THE EIGHT YEARS BEGINS THE DAY AFTER THE DATE OF THE GOVERNOR'S 13 FINAL DECLARATION OF AN EMERGENCY FOR THE DISASTER, INCLUDING 14 ALL EXTENSIONS TO THE DECLARATION. Any county general fund moneys 15 MONEY transferred into the county road and bridge fund must be used for 16 the purposes of disaster response and recovery in a manner consistent 17 with the permissible uses of moneys MONEY in the county road and bridge 18 fund. 19 **SECTION 2.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 20 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 21 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August

5, 2020, if adjournment sine die is on May 6, 2020); except that, if a

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- referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
- state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
- 3 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
- 4 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
- November 2020 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
- 6 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

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
