Department of Law, Special Purpose, Litigation Management -- It is the General Assembly's intent to grant the Department of Law additional flexibility by allowing the Department to use money appropriated to this line item to address unanticipated state legal needs that arise during FY 2019-20. It is also the General Assembly's intent that money spent from this line item shall not require the appropriation of additional FTE and will not be used for any type of salary increase, promotion, reclassification, or bonus related to any present or future FTE employed by the Department of Law.
