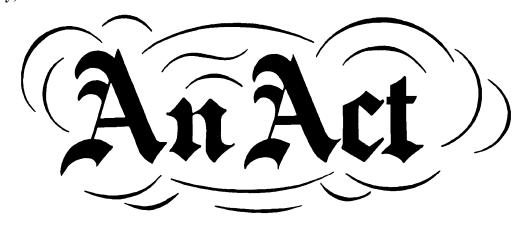

CONCERNING FUNDING FOR CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION, AND MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. Capital construction appropriations for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019. In Session Laws of Colorado 2019, amend section 3 of chapter 454, (SB 19-207), as follows:
