#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE AUGMENTATION OF THE GENERAL FUND THROUGH 102 TRANSFERS OF CERTAIN MONEY.

#### **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. **Joint Budget Committee.** For the purpose of augmenting the amount of revenues in the state general fund, the bill requires the state treasurer to make the following specific transfers to the general fund. On June 30, 2020, the state treasurer is required to transfer the following amounts to the general fund:

\$3,176 from the employment verification fund, as it existed

- prior to its repeal in 2016 (Section 1 of the bill);
- ! \$7.9 million from the Fort Logan land sale account in the capital construction fund (Section 2);
- ! \$8,381,753 from the indirect costs excess recovery fund (Section 3);
- ! \$1,887,116 from the state supplemental security income stabilization fund (**Section 4**);
- ! \$1 million from the veterans assistance grant program cash fund (Section 5);
- ! \$167,463 from the Moffat tunnel cash fund (**Section 6**); and
- ! \$10 million from the multimodal transportation options fund (Section 9).

On July 1, 2020, the state treasurer is required to transfer:

- ! \$45.5 million from the severance tax perpetual base fund to the general fund (**Section 7**); and
- ! \$43 million from the unclaimed property trust fund (Section 8).

All money in the fund is subject to appropriation by the general assembly for the following purposes:
- (a) The severance tax perpetual base fund.

  (XXII) (A) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS SUBSECTION (2)(a) TO THE CONTRARY, ON JULY 1, 2020, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER FORTY-FIVE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS FROM THE FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND.
- (B) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY HEREBY DECLARES THAT THE TRANSFER SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (2)(a)(XXII)(A) OF THIS SECTION IS NECESSARY AS A RESULT OF THE PRECIPITOUS DECREASE IN GENERAL FUND REVENUES AND THAT IT IS THE INTENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO TRANSFER AN EQUAL AMOUNT BACK TO THE FUND AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

20	<b>SECTION 11.</b> Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
21	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
22	preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.

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
