### A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING THE PROHIBITION OF INDICATING AN ASSESSMENT SCORE

# 102 <u>ON A STUDENT'S HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT.</u>

### **Bill Summary**

The bill prohibits a student's assessment score from being indicated on the student's high school transcript unless the student chooses to indicate an assessment score on the transcript.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

1	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-7-1016, amend
2	(2) as follows:
3	22-7-1016. Assessments in high school - transcripts -
4	<b>definition.</b> (2) (a) Each high school student's final transcript shall MUST
5	describe the student's level of postsecondary and workforce readiness by
6	(a) indicating the student's level of performance in the
7	postsecondary and workforce readiness program. and
8	(b) (I) Indicating NOTWITHSTANDING ANY GRADUATION
9	REQUIREMENT ADOPTED BY A LOCAL EDUCATION PROVIDER, EACH HIGH
10	SCHOOL STUDENT'S TRANSCRIPT MUST NOT INDICATE the student's level of
11	performance on the A readiness assessments ASSESSMENT administered to
12	the student pursuant to section 22-7-1006.3 in high school OR ON A
13	NATIONAL <u>ASSESSMENT.</u>
14	(II) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION (2)(b), "NATIONAL
15	ASSESSMENT" MEANS ANY ASSESSMENT THAT IS ADMINISTERED
16	THROUGHOUT THE UNITED STATES TO MEASURE POSTSECONDARY OR
17	WORKFORCE READINESS.
18	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
19	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
20	preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
