Bill Topic: COLORADO YOUTH ADVISORY COUNCIL MEMBERSHIP

Summary of No fiscal impact. This bill modifies the membership of the Colorado Youth Advisory

Council to require a representative of the Southern Ute Tribe and the Ute Mountain

Ute Tribe. It does not affect the revenue or expenditures of any state or local

agency, so it is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Appropriation Summary:

No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status:

The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill.

Summary of Legislation

The bill replaces two at-large members of the Colorado Youth Advisory Council with one representative from the Southern Ute Tribe and one representative from the Ute Mountain Ute Tribe. The number of at-large members is reduced to three.

Background

The Youth Advisory Council is housed in the Legislative Department and receives a \$25,000 annual General Fund appropriation to the Youth Advisory Council Cash Fund. Created in 2008, the Colorado Youth Advisory Council advises and makes recommendations to elected officials about issues that affect Colorado's youth. The Colorado Youth Advisory Council has 44 members and 4 non-voting legislative members. All voting members must be at least 14 years old and no older than 19.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill does not change the number of council members, the number of meetings, or the issues to be considered by the council, so it is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
