Bill Topic: **HOUSING AUTHORITY EXEMPTIONS FROM WATER FEES**

The bill exempts housing authorities from fees levied by water conservancy districts, which may reduce local government revenue beginning in FY 2020-21.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill. This bill was not enacted into law; therefore, the impacts identified in this analysis do not take effect.

Summary of Legislation

Under current law, property owned by any governmental agency within a water conservancy district is exempt from tax assessments and levies imposed by the conservancy district. This bill also exempts property owned by a housing authority within a water conservancy district from any tap fee or development impact fee imposed by a water conservancy district.

Local Government

Where housing authorities are serviced by a water conservancy district, the bill reduces the fee expenditure of that housing authority, and reduces the fee revenue of that conservancy district.

Effective Date

The bill was deemed lost on June 16, 2020.
