Bill Topic: **MOVE ALTERNATIVE FUEL DEFINITION**

Summary of Fiscal Impact: **No fiscal impact.** This bill relocates the definition of alternative fuel from one section of statute to another section and updates references to the definition. It does not affect the revenue or expenditures of any state or local government so is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill recommended by the Statutory Revision Committee.

Summary of Legislation

Under current law, the Department of Personnel and Administration's (DPA) statute references the term "alternative fuel" as defined in the Air Quality Control Program statutes. This bill repeals the section of statute that includes the definition and relocates the definition of alternative fuel to the DPA statute. It also updates all statutory references to the location of the alternative fuel definition and makes other conforming amendments.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

This bill relocates a definition in statute and updates references to the definition. It does not affect the revenue or expenditures of any state or local government. Therefore, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 5, 2020, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 6, 2020, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
