Bill Topic: **SUNSET COLORADO KIDS OUTDOORS ADVISORY COUNCIL**

Summary of Fiscal Impact: **Sunset bill with no fiscal impact.** This bill implements the recommendation of the Department of Regulatory Agencies' sunset review and repeals the Colorado Kids Outdoors Advisory Council.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill.

Summary of Legislation

The bill implements the recommendation of the Department of Regulatory Agencies' sunset review and repeals the Colorado Kids Outdoors Advisory Council.

Background

The Colorado Kids Outdoors Advisory Council was created via House Bill 10-1131 to foster cooperation among state agencies and private organizations related to youth outdoor opportunities, and to improve access to environmental education and awareness of the benefits of outdoor experiences for youth. The council and associated grant program, which is funded with donations only, have been inactive, and no recent revenue, expenditures, or associated workload has been identified.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill does not affect revenue or expenditures for any state or local government agency, and is therefore assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 5, 2020, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 6, 2020, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
