**Bill Topic:** SAFE AND HEALTHY LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS FOR STUDENTS

Summary of No fiscal impact. The bill modifies evaluative criteria used by the Colorado Department of Education when making awards from four existing grant programs. **Fiscal Impact:** 

The bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact on state or local revenue or

expenditures.

**Appropriation** Summary:

No appropriation is required.

**Fiscal Note** Status:

The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill. This bill was not enacted into law;

therefore, the impacts identified in this analysis do not take effect.

## **Summary of Legislation**

The bill modifies the evaluative criteria used by the Colorado Department of Education (CDE) when evaluating grant applications made to the Student Re-engagement Grant Program, the Services for Expelled and At-Risk Students Grant Program, the School Bullying Prevention and Education Grant Program, and the Behavioral Health Care Professional Matching Grant Program.

## **Assessment of No Fiscal Impact**

This bill makes no changes to the specified grant programs' annual funding or basic operations. The bill merely expands the criteria the CDE must use to evaluate applications and prioritize grant awards. This change does not increase workload or expenditures for the program. For these reasons, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

#### **Effective Date**

The bill was postponed indefinitely by the House Education Committee on May 26, 2020.
