Summary of Legislation

The bill replaces the term illegal alien with unauthorized worker as it relates to state government contracts for services.

The bill will increase workload for state agencies that may have to update contract templates and forms for future contracts. This increase in workload can be accomplished within existing appropriations.

Effective Date

The bill was postponed indefinitely by the Senate State, Veterans, and Military Affairs Committee on May 27, 2020.
