

## **Summary of Legislation**

Under current law, institutions of higher education must require a national assessment test score as one of the criteria used to determine eligibility for admission of first-time freshman students. This bill permits each state supported institution to decide if it will require a national assessment test score for freshman students who graduated from high school in 2021.

## **Assessment of No Fiscal Impact**

The bill extends permissive authority to state institutions of higher education to consider admissions eligibility of 2021 high school graduates with or without a national assessment test score. The bill does not impact the revenue or expenditures of any state agency, local government, or institution of higher education and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

## **Effective Date**

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
